Bicycle Room Policy

- 1) Each bicycle spot is designated for one adult size bicycle. One small child bicycle can be attached to one adult size bicycle.
- 2) Spots are meant for bikes in use. If you have not used your bike in the past 2 years, remove the bicycle from the bicycle room and surrender your spot. Empty spots for more than 2 months are subject to reassignment by the Bike Committee to any units on the waitlist.
- 3) No storage of items other than bicycles in the bicycle room, including loose bicycle parts.
- 4) Bicycles in unassigned spaces are subject to removal by the Bike Committee.
- 5) No visitors' bicycles are allowed in the bicycle room. Visitors' bicycles shall be parked on the bike rack next to the main entrance of the building.
- 7) For new or additional spot requests please fill out the Bike Form, available at the Office.
- 8) The change in number of registered bicycles per household shall be reported to the Bike Committee by submitting a Bike Form to the Office.
- 9.) The Bike Committee is responsible for maintaining the list of assigned spots, all changes, and the waiting list for spots.
- 10.) The Bike Committee shall occasionally review the list of registered bicycles and verify the registration status against parked bicycles at designated spots.
- 11.) Unregistered and unclaimed bicycles identified during spot verification are subject to disposal arranged by the Bike Committee.
- 12.) The Bike Committee does not take any liability for removal of unclaimed bicycles.
- 13) Violation of this policy might result in a member losing their bicycle spot.
